## Shade Card

On the following page is an image of a GREY SCALE to be used for colour blending.

Print this out on thin card or laminate your sheet of paper for ease of use.
Punch a 5 mm hole (use one hole from a two-hole punch, or a leather punch) in the centre of each numbered shade strip (11 in all).

To use, hold the card over the yarn you wish to evaluate, with the yarn visible through one or more holes.

When the hole in the card becomes at its least conspicuous, that is the value of the yarn you are testing. If you find others of similar or close valuations, then your yarns will blend well together.
